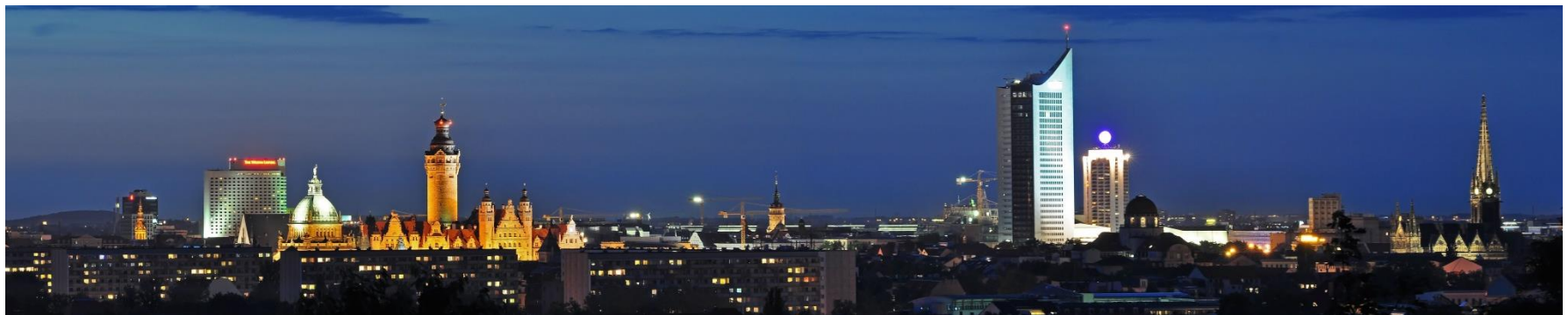


One weekend a month we spend at HHL
